You have been convicted and sentenced to pay the following fines and mandatory surcharges:

YOUR FAILURE TO TIMELY PAY by the date set forth below will result in a **judgment** being entered against you and docketed with the **SUFFOLK COUNTY CLERK**, (or the Clerk of the County in which you reside) in the amount of any unpaid money; and/or the **suspension** of your driver's license; and/or a bench **warrant** for your arrest.

Criminal Procedure Law 420.40 provides that the Court may not waive a mandatory surcharge or crime victim assistance fee. The court may defer payment thereof and enter a civil judgment in the amount thereof, or you may be imprisoned for up to fifteen (15) days for your failure to pay. At the hearing you may present credible and verifiable information establishing that payment thereof will work an unreasonable hardship on you or your immediate family.

Criminal Procedure Law 420.10(3) provided that if you fail to pay a fine imposed by the court, within the time ordered, you may be imprisoned for up to one-third the maximum term which could have been imposed for your conviction (up to fifteen (15) days for a petty offense). Criminal Procedure Law 420.10(6) provides that a civil judgment may be filed with the Suffolk County clerk in the amount of any unpaid fines.

Criminal Procedure Law 420.10(3) and (5) provide that if you are unable to pay a fine, you may apply to the court, at any time, to be re-sentenced.

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La ley de procederá criminal, número 420.40, proporciona que el Tribunal no puede renunciar una sobrecarga ni honorario obligatoria de la ayuda de víctima de crimen. El Tribunal puede diferir el pago del mismo y entra un juicio civil en la cantidad del mismo, o usted puede ser encarcelado hasta quince (15) días para su falta de paga. En la audición, usted puede presentar establecer creíble y verificable de información ese pago del mismo trabajara una dificultad desrazonable en usted o en su familia más cerca.

Le ley de procederá criminal, numero 420.40(3) proporciona que si usted falla de pagar una multa impuesta por el Tribunal, dentro del tiempo ordenado, usted puede ser encarcelado hasta la tercera parte del termino máximo que pudiera haber sido impuesto para su convicción (hasta quince (15) días para una ofensa insignificante) proporciona que un juicio civil puede ser archivado con el Empleado de Condado de Suffolk en la cantidad de alguna multa impagada.

La ley de procederá criminal 420.10 (3) y (5) proporciona que si usted puede non pagar una multa, usted puede aplicar al Tribunal, en tiempo, para ser sentenciado otra vez.
